Your 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm information you and/or your parents reported on your FAFSA. Your FAFSA, the information on this worksheet and any other required documents will be compared. If there are differences, corrections may be required. You may be asked for additional information. Try to complete verification as soon as possible, so that your financial aid won't be delayed. **Talk to your financial aid administrator if you have questions about completing this worksheet.**
