Vision of the Boerne Church of Christ: To bring Christ and his heart for the home to every family

Mission of the Boerne Church of Christ: Our mission is to develop spiritual lives rooted in Jesus Christ, enabling the message of salvation to grow and spread in Boerne and the world.

Qualifications:

- Baptized believer in the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
- Current College Student with an interest in ministry, whether it be full-time, part-time, or volunteer in their future plans
- Male Applicants only

Responsibilities:

- Maintain and grow personal relationship with God through practice of Spiritual Disciplines
- Mentor and build relationships with Middle School and High School students of the Boerne Church of Christ
- Be present at all Worship Services and Church functions as expected by Church Leadership throughout the length of employment
- Teach a Sunday Morning Bible Class and lead a Wednesday Night Small Group
- Help plan and develop weekly Wednesday Night Youth Group Activities
- Coordinate and assist with Group Trips such as: Mission Trip, Encounter, and SCYC @ Camp Bandina
- Plan, coordinate, and be present at other youth group functions throughout the Summer
- Depending on your personal gifts/talents, intern may do one or more of the following:
 - Lead Singing (Sunday or Wednesdays)
 - Preach
 - Teach Adult or Children's Class
- Assist with Children's Ministry needs when necessary, primarily Vacation Bible School

Expectations:

- Length of Internship: 10 weeks (Sunday, May 28-Sunday, August 6)
 - Intern is expected to coordinate any extended time off with Youth and Family Minister, Jacob Dukes, prior to employment start
- Office Hours: Tuesday-Friday (9:00-3:00)
 - Intern will always receive Monday's off
 - 1 hour lunch break each day
- Intern will maintain boundaries with students, such as but not limited to:
 - Meeting in Groups of 3 only, no one-on-one meetings with any students
 - Refraining from texting female students within the youth group
 - Avoid all situations where you may find yourself alone with a female student or adult volunteer/chaperone
- Complete Background Check and any Child Safety Training provided by the Boerne Church of Christ
- Intern will attend any necessary Leadership meetings, such as: Elders Meetings, Deacons Meetings, Staff Meetings

Compensation/Transportation/Lodging:

- \$450 per week for 10 weeks = \$4500 total
- All food, lodging, and other necessary expenses will be covered for intern at the discretion of Youth and Family Minister, Jacob Dukes
- Intern will be provided housing by the Boerne Church of Christ
- Intern is expected to provide their own means of transportation to and from internship and to and from housing to Church office. Intern may also coordinate transportation with Youth and Family Minister, Jacob Dukes, if necessary.
 - Transportation will be provided to intern on all Summer Trips, such as: Mission Trip, Encounter, and SCYC @ Camp Bandina
